Distinguished Young Professional Award Submission Format

SUBMISSION FORMAT: Application packet must include the following for consideration:

Narratives must be a maximum of four (4) pages using the following formatting requirements:

- Double spaced
- Margins on narrow setting (.50 on all sides)
- Font size is Times New Roman, size 12
- Ink color is black
- All narratives must include a header and footer with the following:
 - Header – use three column format with the agency name on the left, project title in the center and 2023 on the right.
 - Footer – use center format with the page number.
- ***Eligibility:***
 - Nominee must be an active TRPA member and preferably NRPA.
 - Nominee must have served three to five years on the professional level in Parks and Recreation and served in the State of Tennessee at least two consecutive years.
 - Certification is preferred. If the nominee is in the process of being certified, please indicate their progress.
 - Nominee must not be over 35 years of age.
- ***Additional Requirements or Information:***
 - *Narrative* – please include:
 - List memberships in professional organizations, local, state, regional and national levels. Indicate if membership is current or past.
 - List awards, recognitions and honors from professional associations/societies, community groups and the appropriate dates.
 - Attach a biographical statement that best exemplifies the qualities of the nominee during the awards period (detailed information).
 - *Photos* - No more than TWO (2) photos of the nominee may be included in digital form.
