If the park or facility is renovated in phases, it may be submitted at the completion of any phase; additionally, a facility that is part of a larger park may be entered as a stand-alone submission (for example, a renovated tennis complex added in an existing park.) There are two separate awards for this category – submitted within project budgets. An agency can apply for no more than one (1) in each of the budget levels.
